

Haryana to 'push again' for promotion of 27 HCS officers to IAS after UPSC returns file

UPSC points out chargesheet against eight HCS officers of the 2002 batch

DAYS AFTER the Union Public Service Commission returned a Haryana government proposal for the elevation of 27 Haryana Civil Services (HCS) officers to the Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officers, senior officials have indicated that "the state government will give it another shot, factoring in concerns raised by the Commission".

The state government sent the proposal to the UPSC in March, seeking promotions to 27 HCS officers of 2002, 2003 and 2004 batches to the IAS officers, but the Commission returned the proposal, pointing out "pending chargesheets" against eight of the 2002 batch HCS officers, Haryana government sources said.

In 2023, the Anti-Corruption Bureau (ACB) filed a chargesheet in a Hisar court, alleging irregularities in the recruitment of the 2002 batch of HCS officers, impeding the promotion of several HCS officers for the past few years.

However, on Monday, a Haryana government officer said, "The UPSC has only returned the proposal, but has not

taken a final call on it." Indicating that "the proposal will be sent again" to the UPSC, the officer said, "The matter is under consideration to put up a fresh proposal before the chief minister for his approval."

The state has three vacancies for the 2020 batch, four for the 2021 batch, eight for the 2022 batch, 10 for the 2023 batch and two for the 2024 batch.

Following a legal opinion, the state government conveyed to the UPSC in March that "the term chargesheet cannot be construed as the final form/report submitted under section 173 of the CrPC".

After examining the matter, the UPSC decided to take a legal opinion from the Department of Legal Affairs, and subsequently, the Solicitor General gave his opinion to the commission on May 11.

The Solicitor General did not agree with the state government's opinion that a "chargesheet cannot be construed as the final report under section 173 CrPC".

"All the cases where the report under section 173 CrPC is filed, it would be treated as filing of the chargesheets as stipulated in 'Regulations 5 (5) of the IAS Regulations, 1955', the Solicitor

General opined.

The Solicitor General also mentioned, "Section 173 is the stage at which the investigation is complete subject to further investigation which can be conducted under section 173(8) of the code... the term 'chargesheet' is not defined in the CrPC, it is used as a legally acceptable expression for the report under section 173 of the code. In some states, it is also called 'challan'. It is this chargesheet which is contemplated in Regulation 5(5) of the IAS Regulation, 1955. This is clear from the judgment of the Supreme Court in Gurpreet Singh Bhullar & another versus Union Of India & Others. There are other judicial pronouncements on the subject, also. However, with the issue being well settled, it may not be necessary to multiply the citations."

Given the SG's opinion, the UPSC requested the state government to examine the case and furnish the amended relevant documents so that the proposals for the select lists of 2020 to 2024 are processed further.

Another Haryana government officer said, "The Solicitor General's opinion will be taken into account while drafting a fresh proposal for the promotion

of HCS officers."

Earlier, opposing the proposal for the promotion of 2002-batch HCS officers, Congress leader and former minister Karan Singh Dalal in March had sent a letter to the President, seeking her intervention into the matter.

In December 2023 too, he had sent a letter to the UPSC chairman, "opposing" the proposal for the promotion of these officers, adding that the ACB had found the selection of HCS officers of the 2002 batch to be "tainted". "They were also charged with several offences, including forgery, cheating and corruption. They have been summoned by a Hisar court and are also facing trial," Dalal had stated.

A former MLA from Palwal, Dalal had earlier challenged the 2002 selection process in the Punjab and Haryana High Court when 86 candidates were selected by the HPSC during the Indian National Lok Dal government's tenure.

The court had found irregularities in the selection process of 38 candidates and ordered the state Vigilance Bureau (now ACB) to examine the entire case. Dalal had also taken up the issue to the Supreme Court.

PSU stages protest against proposal to convert Ludhiana govt college land into parking area

THE PUNJAB Students' Union (PSU) on Monday staged a protest outside the Deputy Commissioner's office in Ludhiana against the proposal to convert the land of Government College for Girls into a car parking area. A memorandum was submitted to Chief Minister's Regional Officer Upinderjit Kaur.

Notably, a Rajya Sabha member from Ludhiana —

while addressing the issues of traffic congestion in the city a few days ago — had suggested to Education Minister Harjot Bains that a parking lot be built on the premises of the Ludhiana college, near a religious site. The reason given — "this will curb traffic congestion due to heavy footfall at the religious site".

Calling the Rajya Sabha member's suggestion to build a parking lot on the college premises "extremely unfortunate", PSU's state president Ranveer Singh Kurar, who led the

protest, said: "When the Punjab government came to power, it promised an education revolution. Now, it is eyeing the land of educational institutions." He also mentioned the college has only one ground where events, athletic meetings, and other functions are conducted.

"The government's duty is to develop colleges, not destroy them," Kurar said.

"On one hand, we lament our country is not winning enough Olympic medals. But if we turn playgrounds into parking lots, where will students

practice?" protesters questioned jointly, suggesting alternatives like railway land or Guru Nanak Stadium parking lot for the purpose.

Accusing the government of "forcible pillar construction" on the pretext of parking, protesters said the "real motive was to grab the college's prime land worth crores".

Vowing to resist this move strongly, the PSU students warned "if the government does not reverse this decision they will stage a protest outside the residence of Sanjeev Arora".

Summer vacation in Punjab schools from June 2-30: Education minister

ALL SCHOOLS in Punjab, including government, private and aided, will be closed for summer vacations from June 2 to 30.

Punjab Education Minister Harjot Singh Bains, in a post on X, said, "In view of the heatwave in Punjab, all Government, Aided, Recognized, and Private schools in the state will remain closed for summer vacation from June 2 to June 30, 2025."

Even as summer vacations have been announced from June

2 to 30, some schools in the state might remain open for a week or so during this period as schools are planning summer camps to engage children in fun activities, according to officials.

In a separate order, the government has also directed schools to arrange a week long language camp for classes 6 to 10 where Punjab students will learn basic Telugu language while their counterparts in Andhra Pradesh will learn Punjabi under Centre's Bharatiya Bhasha Summer Camp initiative to promote multilingualism.

Handing over of Bhakra Dam security to CISF 'authoritarian' move by Centre, say SKM leaders

THE SAMYUKTA Kisan Morcha (SKM) has termed the Union government's move to hand over the security of Bhakra Dam to the Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) as an "authoritarian" step, "undermining the constitutional federal structure and further strengthening the trend of centralisation of power".

In a press statement, SKM leaders condemned the move: "The unilateral administrative decisions taken by the Bhakra Beas Management Board (BBMB) for the past several days are biased and influenced by the BJP-led Union government."

Holding the Dam Safety Act as "directly responsible" for this action, the SKM demanded to "repeal the Act, which is against the states' constitutional rights".

"History shows the river water dispute between Punjab and its neighbouring states has always been politicised instead of resolving in a non-discriminatory, rational and people-friendly manner in the light of riparian/scientific principles," the leaders said.

"The dispute between Punjab and Haryana by the BBMB is also motivated by the hidden political interests of the BJP-led Union government," SKM national co-ordination committee member Dr Darshan Pal said.

"The water crisis in north-west India is becoming serious due to the falling groundwater level and water pollution. To resolve this crisis, the Union and state governments should formulate a multi-layered action policy," SKM leaders said.

SKM leaders stressed formulating a policy of watershed development and water harvesting to recharge the depleting groundwater level. "Also, there is a need to encourage agriculture research and cultivation of sustainable, environment-friendly and diverse crops with adequate, scientific use of water, fertilisers and insecticides and enact a law to guarantee crop procurement as per the Swaminathan formula, while not compromising on the food security of the people," they said.

SKM leaders reiterated their commitment to press the Union and state governments to resolve the water crisis without discrimination or bias. They appealed to the people "to be wary of political tactics of ruling class parties, especially the BJP, to pit the people of the neighbouring states, especially the farmers, against each other".
